



Good Faith Estimate / No Surprises Act

Now available for patients without health insurance & insured patients paying out of pocket for care without filing an insurance claim

Tri-State Orthopaedics & Sports Medicine and Tri-State Physical Therapy is pleased to comply with a new law that requires health care providers to give patients an estimate of their bills for health care services before patients receive them if patients do not have health insurance or they are choosing not to use their health insurance for their care.

You have the right to receive a Good Faith Estimate for the total expected cost of any health care service or item.

<u>Upon request</u>, if you schedule a health care service at least 3 business days in advance, we will provide a written Good Faith Estimate to you within 1 business day after scheduling.

If you receive a bill that is at least \$400 more than your Good Faith Estimate from that provider or facility, you may dispute the bill.

Always save a copy or picture of your Good Faith Estimate and the bill.
